Face of the Player






Left Side of the Touchscreen

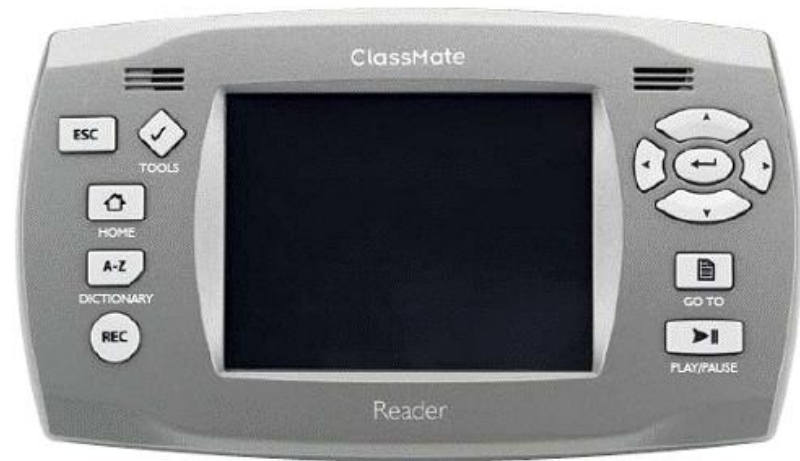
-  : **Escape**
-  : **Study Tools**
-  : **Home**
-  : **Dictionary**
-  : **Record**



- Microphone is located above the study tools

Right Side of the Touchscreen

-  : **Four-way arrow navigation** buttons with the **Enter** button in the middle.
-  : **Go to Page/Header** button
-  : **Play / Pause** button






- Speaker is located above the up arrow

Left Edge of the Player




On the left edge of the player, starting at the back, you will find:

-  : **Headphones jack**
-  : **Volume/Speed Up and Down**
-  : **Volume and Speed toggle button**

Right Edge of the Player




On the right edge of the player, starting at the back of the player, you will find:

-  : the **Power** button
- the **SD card slot**
- the **built-in stylus**.


Top Edge of the Player



When facing the top edge, you will find on the left:

-  : **Mini USB connector.** This is used to copy books from USB storage devices or to play material saved on USB memory sticks.

On the right side:

-  : **Power input jack.** It is used to connect the player to an electrical outlet.

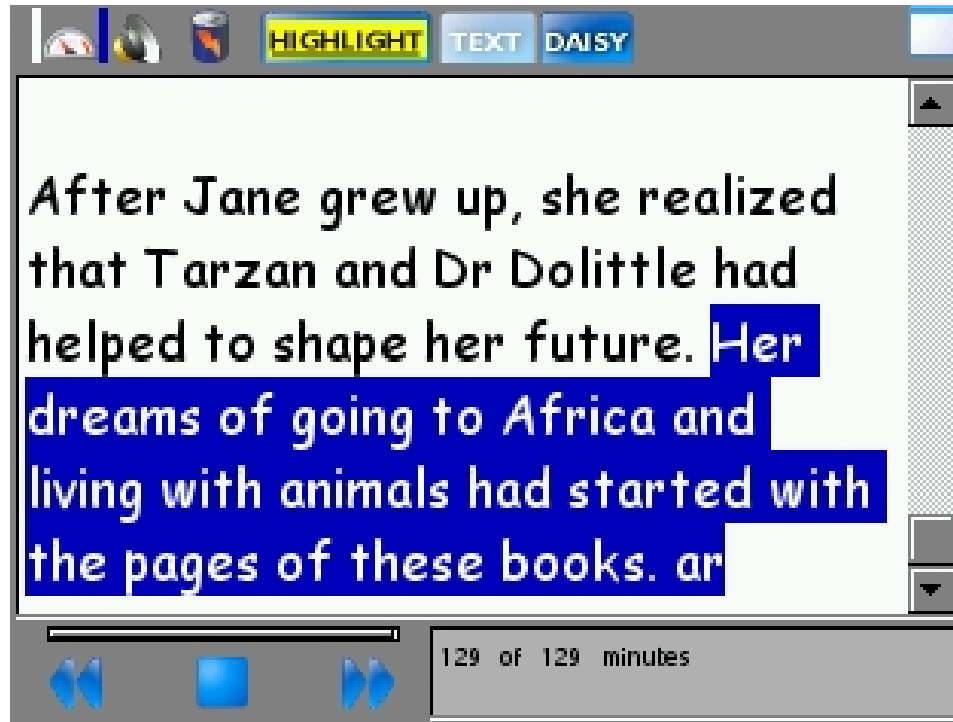
Backside of the Player



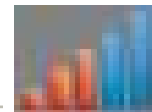

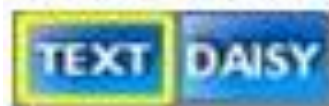

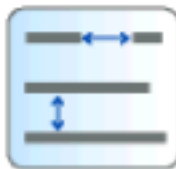
